



Release of Police Department Investigation Report

The City of Manitowoc will release the Manitowoc City Police Department Investigation Report compiled by DeWitt, Ross & Stevens, S.C., in its entirety, beginning at 11:00am on Wednesday, October 3, 2007. The 79 page report will only be available in hard copy and anyone requesting a copy of it will be required to pay the cost of copying the report at \$19.75 per each report. Persons interested in receiving a copy of the report should notify the City Attorney/Personnel office at 920-686-6993 or 920-686-6990 on or before 4:00pm, tomorrow/Tuesday, October 2, 2007 to ensure there are enough copies available for all those who wish to receive one. Copies will continue to be available after Wednesday as well.

All of the time frames for prohibiting the release of the Report will have expired on October 2, 2007. Persons considered record subjects in the Report were given notice by certified mail of their right to oppose a release of the report. No person named in the report has filed an objection to its release.

As we previously stated, “All of the Alders and the Mayor want the results of this investigation and its outcome available for public scrutiny as soon as possible”.

The year-long investigation represents an investment by the City of Manitowoc to examine allegations, accusations and all related incidents concerning the Manitowoc Police Department to uncover the truth, resolve issues and establish the Manitowoc Police Department as a premiere provider of public safety.

“The citizens of Manitowoc will overcome this challenge. We are a solid and resilient community. While the issues will take time to resolve, our focus will remain centered on continued success as individuals and as a city.”

On another note, Curt Mauer of Commercial Horizons, the developer building HarborTown, reported that the earthwork, which is the first stage of construction for our Kohl’s store, will begin this week. Kohl’s new presence underscores the strength of our local economy.
