The Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, Wisconsin, met in adjourned session at the Council Chambers in City Hall, on Monday, April 22, 2013. Said meeting was duly called, noticed, held and conducted in the manner required by the Common Council and the pertinent Wisconsin Statutes.

In the absence of Mayor Justin Nickels, the meeting was called to order at 6:16 p.m. by Acting Mayor Jill Hennessey and on roll call the following members were present: Alderpersons Dave Soeldner, Jim Brey, Allan Schema, Mike Howe, Christopher Able, Jason Sladky, Scott McMeans, Eric Sitkiewitz, Tyler Martell and Jill Hennessey.

Resolution (13-183) supporting the Consent Agreement between the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Lake Michigan Carferry Service/S.S. Badger allowing their continued positive economic impact on the City of Manitowoc, was referred to Committee of the Whole.

Resolution (13-182) endorsing and recommending the Manitowoc County Board and Highway Committee to reconstruct the C.T.H. "R" (Rapids Road) roadway and bridge with a 4-lane facility and a shared use path for bikes and pedestrians on the east side of Rapids Road, was referred to Streets and Sanitation Committee.

Acting Mayor declared a brief recess to allow for Committee to obtain signatures and then called the meeting back to order.

Committee of the Whole returned resolution (13-183) supporting the Consent Agreement between the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Lake Michigan Carferry Service/S.S. Badger allowing their continued positive economic impact on the City of Manitowoc, recommending acceptance of the resolution.

Motion by Sladky, second by Able, and unanimously carried to accept the Committee's report. Ayes, 10. Nays, none.

Parks and Recreation Committee returned addendum (13- 185) to Contract dated December 4, 2012, with MCM Excavating and Landscaping to grade and seed 7.6 acres of City of Manitowoc owned Silveridge Park, recommending entering into contract amendment. Motion by Sladky, second by Soeldner, and unanimously carried to accept the Committee's report. Ayes, 10. Nays, none.

Streets and Sanitation Committee returned request (13-133) from SMI as representatives of City Centre LLC for a variance for a commercial driveway width greater than 35 feet for a site at the northeast corner of S. 16th and Wollmer Streets for proposed boat storage building, recommending approval. Motion by Soeldner, second by Brey, and unanimously carried to accept the Committee's report. Ayes, 10. Nays, none.

Streets and Sanitation Committee returned resolution (13-182) endorsing and recommending the Manitowoc County Board and Highway Committee to reconstruct the C.T.H. "R" (Rapids Road) roadway and bridge with a 4-lane facility and a shared use path for bikes and pedestrians on the east side of Rapids Road, recommending adoption. Motion by Soeldner, second by Brey, and unanimously carried to accept the Committee's report. Ayes, 10. Nays, none.

Public Utilities and Licensing Committee returned #27 for Temporary Class "B" Retail Fermented Malt Beverage license; #2 for Temporary "Class B" Retail Wine license; granting the various licenses, as shown on the committee's report. Motion by Sladky, second by Able, and unanimously carried to accept the Committee's report. Ayes, 10. Nays, none.

Moved by Sladky, second by Able, and unanimously carried, Common Council adjourned at 6:16 p.m.
