The meeting was called to order at 5:55 p.m. by Chairman Sitkiewitz.

The first item discussed was a request by Director of Building Inspection Jim Muenzenmeyer to contract out commercial electrical inspections during absences of the Electrical Inspector. Mr. Muenzenmeyer stated that he'd like to hire Bill Nichols to conduct commercial electrical inspections only when necessary as the current electrical inspector has an on-going illness that may require him to be off duty from time to time. Alderman Jason Sladky stated that he feels hiring Bill Nichols, a local contractor, to perform the inspections is a conflict of interest because he would be inspecting his competitor's work. Additional discussion ensued. Mr. Muenzenmeyer was directed to find other options for the committee to consider. No further action was taken.

The last item on the agenda was a request from the Fire Chief to review a disputed ambulance bill. As this subject was to be discussed in closed session, Chairman Sitkiewitz read the proper notice at 6:04 p.m. The motion to enter into closed session was made by Jim Brey and seconded by Scott McMeans. The vote was unanimous to go into closed session at 6:08 p.m. During the closed session the vote to deny the claim was made by Jim Brey and seconded by Nic Levendusky. The vote to deny the claim was unanimous. Jim Brey made a motion to end the closed session with Nic Levendusky providing the second. As all were in favor of ending the closed session, the committee entered back into regular session at 6:08 p.m.

There being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 6:09 p.m.
