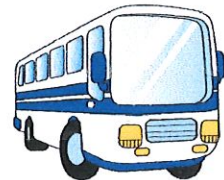


The Member Appreciation Bus is heading to

*The Paine is a Tudor Revival-Style country estate built in 1925. The mansion reflects the traditions of the time and the craftsmanship, décor and artwork were inspired by English country houses. The architect varied the interior and exterior features to give it the appearance of being built over three centuries. The gardens consist of 20 areas and were enlarged in 2017 by a new elaborate formal garden designed by an internationally recognized landscape architect. The featured exhibit this summer is titled *Maker & Muse: Women and Early Twentieth Century Art Jewelry*. This exhibit consists of 200 mini-masterpieces and is the largest jewelry exhibit ever presented in Wisconsin.*
