

Joint Meeting:
Public Property and Safety Committee / Public Utilities and Licensing
Committee
February 8, 2011

Chairman Brey called the meeting to order at 5:15 PM.

The approval of the minutes from the December 14th 2010 Public Property and Safety meeting were approved as submitted by a motion from Alder Levendusky. The motion was seconded by Alder Olson and was passed unanimously.

The first item on the agenda was a discussion and possible action to the revision to Chapter 17 of the Manitowoc Municipal Code regarding Cross Contamination Control. Jim Muenzenmeyer described the efforts to date. Manitowoc Public Utilities General Manager Nilaksh Kothari informed the committee of the utility's commitment to send out the notices with the enforcement of the new ordinance to continue to be the responsibility of the Inspection Department. Further discussion ensued. Mr. Muenzenmeyer recommended to the committee that the ordinance be sent to the City Attorney's office for final writing after the Code Review Committee meeting to be held February 10, 2010. Alder Levendusky made a motion to move the recommendation and Alder Olson seconded it. As all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously.

At this point, the Joint Meeting with Public Utilities and Licensing ended, (5:35 p.m.).

The last item for the Public Property and Safety Committee is an update and possible action as to the status of Cabin #1 replacement at Lincoln Park. Jim Muenzenmeyer informed the committee of the size, location, funding, layout, and the possibility of a local service organization constructing the building at no cost to the City. After further discussions, a motion was made by Alder Olson and seconded by Alder Levendusky to approve the basic size and location of the replacement of Cabin #1. As all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously. There being no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
