The Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, Wisconsin, met in accordance with Section 62.11 (2) of the Wisconsin Statutes on Tuesday, April 19, 2011. Said meeting was duly called, noticed, held and conducted in the manner required by the Common Council and the pertinent Wisconsin Statutes.

Mayor Justin M. Nickels called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m., and on roll call of the new Council, the following members were present: Alderpersons Lee Thennes, Christopher Able, Matt Kadow, Alex J. Olson, Jill Hennessey, Dave Soeldner, Allan Schema and Jason Sladky.

Absent: Alderpersons Scott McMeans and James N. Brey.

Pledge.

Invocation.

City Clerk previously administered the oaths of office to newly elected Council members: Lee Thennes (District 1), Christopher Able (District 3), Jill Hennessey (District 7) and Jason Sladky (District 10).

Mayor Nickels announced that nominations were in order for the election of President of the Common Council, who also acts as Chaplain.

Moved by Alderperson Kadow , seconded by Alderperson Thennes, to nominate Alderperson Christopher Able as President of the Common Council.

Moved by Alderperson Olson to nominate Alderperson James N. Brey as President of the Common Council. Motion failed for lack of a second.

There being no other nominations, it was moved by Alderperson Soeldner, seconded by Alderperson Kadow, and unanimously carried to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot. Ayes, 8, Nays, none.

Mayor declared Alderperson Able elected as President of the Common Council and the City Clerk then administered the oath of office.

The Common Council rules were distributed for approval. Moved by Alderperson Sladky, second by Alderperson Thennes, and unanimously carried to adopt the Council Rules as presented. Ayes, 8. Nays, none. (Common Council rules are on file with 2011-2012 Council matters.)

Members proceeded to draw for seats with the results being as follows: Seat/Name – (1) Sladky, (2) Soeldner, (3) Schema, (4) Thennes, (5) Hennessey, (6) Kadow, (7) Brey, (8) McMeans, (9) Olson and (10) Able. Past Council President Dave Soeldner drew for Alderpersons Brey and McMeans in their absence.

Mayor Nickels declared a brief recess to allow for members to take their new seats and then called the meeting back to order.

Upon motion of Alderperson Kadow, seconded by Alderperson Able, Common Council adjourned at 5:15 o'clock P.M.
