The Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, Wisconsin, met in accordance with Section 62.11 (2) of the Wisconsin Statutes on Tuesday, April 17, 2012. Said meeting was duly called, noticed, held and conducted in the manner required by the Common Council and the pertinent Wisconsin Statutes.

Mayor Justin M. Nickels called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m., and on roll call of the new Council, the following members were present: Alderpersons Scott McMeans, Christopher Able, Jim Brey, Tyler Martell, Eric J. Sitkiewitz, Jill Hennessey, Allan Schema and Jason Sladky.

Absent: Alderpersons Collin Braunel and Dave Soeldner.

Pledge.

Invocation.

City Clerk administered the oaths of office to newly elected Council members: Jim Brey (District 4), Tyler Martell (District 5), Eric J. Sitkiewitz (District 6) and Allan Schema (District 9). Mayor Nickels announced that nominations were in order for the election of President of the Common Council, who also acts as Chaplain.

Moved by Alderperson Able, seconded by Alderperson Brey, to nominate Alderperson Jason Sladky as President of the Common Council.

There being no other nominations, it was moved by Alderperson Able, seconded by Alderperson Brey, and unanimously carried to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot. Ayes, 8, Nays, none.

Mayor declared Alderperson Sladky elected as President of the Common Council and the City Clerk then administered the oath of office.

The Common Council rules were distributed for approval. Moved by Alderperson Able, second

by Alderperson Schema, and unanimously carried to adopt the Council Rules as presented. Ayes, 8. Nays, none. (Common Council rules are on file with 2012-2013 Council matters.)

Members proceeded to draw for seats with the results being as follows: Seat/Name - (1) Sitkiewitz, (2) McMeans, (3) Braunel, (4) Martell, (5) Brey, (6) Soeldner, (7) Schema, (8) Able, (9) Hennessey and (10) Sladky.

Mayor Nickels declared a brief recess to allow for members to take their new seats and then called the meeting back to order.

Public Utilities and Licensing returned lease (12-260) between City of Manitowoc and Lake Michigan Trans-Lake Shortcut, Inc. with a minority report recommending entering into the lease. Motion by Hennessey, second by Sladky, and unanimously carried to accept the Committee's report. Ayes, 8. Nays, none.

Upon motion of Alderperson Sladky, seconded by Alderperson Able, Common Council adjourned at 5:16 o'clock P.M.
