Monday, September 24, 2012

The Common Council of the City of Manitowoc, Wisconsin, met in adjourned session at the Council Chambers in City Hall, on Monday, September 24, 2012. Said meeting was duly called, noticed, held and conducted in the manner required by the Common Council and the pertinent Wisconsin Statutes.

Mayor Nickels called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. and on roll call the following members were present: Alderpersons Eric J. Sitkiewitz, Scott McMeans, Collin Braunel, Tyler Martell, Jim Brey, Dave Soeldner, Allan Schema, Jill Hennessey and Jason Sladky

Absent: Alderperson Christopher Able.

Pledge of Allegiance.

A moment of silence on the anniversary of the death of Officer Dale TenHaken.

Streets and Sanitation Committee returned request (12-560) from Dir. Public Works/Engineer/Parks & Recreation Valerie Mellon to continue with cooperative agreement with the County to Satisfy Eligibility for Recycling Consolidation Grant for the purpose of implementing efficiencies related to operating an effective recycling program, recommending entering into agreement. Motion by Soeldner, second by Brey, and unanimously carried to accept the Committee's report. Ayes, 9. Nays, none.

Parks and Recreation Committee brought back report (12-380) of City Plan Commission relative to funding of future Silveridge Park improvements. Moved by Sladky, second by Soeldner, and unanimously carried to rescind Council's action of 9/17/12. Ayes, 9. Nays, none.

After a short discussion, it was moved by Soeldner, second by Sladky to approve an expenditure of no more than \$10,070.00 from the Parkland Dedication Fund for seeding of Silver Ridge Park.

Moved by Hennessey, second by Braunel, to amend the motion to grant the award to MCM provided that it uses the same amount of seed per acre as Hamp Haven Farms. After a short discussion, Alderperson Hennessey withdraw her motion to amend.

Vote on the original motion: Ayes, 8. Nays, 1. Motion carried.

Mayor Nickels presentation of the 2013 Executive Budget. Discussion followed with Mayor answering questions from the Alderpersons.

Motion by McMeans, second by Braunel, and unanimously carried to call for the public hearing on the proposed General City Budget to be held on Monday, November 5, 2012, at 7:10 p.m. Ayes, 9. Nays, none.
