3) Treasure Report: Approved. First by Bob, second by Rita.

4) Request for public input: No public input.

5) Membership Matters: Alex Vergenz will be the new representative from Lutheran High School. Bob Dewane's twin daughters will be representing Roncalli together. Memphys Seizert is an 8th grade student from Washington that will be replacing Christel Erickson next year as a freshman.

6) TRIAD Update: The new project is PSA on scams and a speaker came to the meeting to speak about the Medicaid card.

7) High School Members Update: Christel reports nothing new at Lincoln High School as she didn't have a chance to speak with her SRO. Payton reports Valders High School had an active shooter drill. He also reports students have been taking Adderall to help focus. He reports they get it prescribed from a doctor and have been selling it to their friends.

8) SRO Update: Officer Miranda Check from Lincoln High School reported that there were two terrorists threats (school shooter) in one week. There have been two physical fights and December has been the month for drugs. She took 16 grams of marijuana from a student. The student was being detained in the office for a different reason . When escorting the student out of the office she grabbed his backpack and noticed it smelled like marijuana. She searched the bag and found the drugs.

Memphys Seizert provided the report for Officer Laabs at Washington. He reported 221 DARE graduates at the 2017 DARE graduation. DARE for the 6th grade will start in February. Kids were making a mess in the bathroom soaking paper towels and leaving them in the sink. The students were caught and are now spending time after school cleaning.
