Mayor Justin Nickels declared the meeting open for the Public Hearing to hear any and all interested parties on special assessments for public improvements to take place on all property fronting upon both sides of Dewey Street from South 10<sup>th</sup> Street to South 26<sup>th</sup> Street, including the full width of the street to the center of the intersection and all side street frontages within the project limits.
