### 1. Crime Prevention Monthly Activities – Sgt. Jacobs

- Sgt. Jacobs helping out with SRO duties at Wilson as SRO Bennett has been moved back to Lincoln four days a week to cover for SRO Jansen who is out on medical leave
- Citizen's Academy is going very well. Shared stories /Bob Dewane about Bob being sprayed with pepper spray.

Discussed dynamics surrounding truancy issues and how they are also seeing issues in the elementary and junior high schools. SRO Bennett will be teaching DARE classes at Madison in April. He has also given some bullying presentations within the elementary schools as this is a major issue that needs to be addressed and prevented. The positive message SRO Bennett shared is that the majority of the kids at Lincoln are good kids doing good

things and are on the right track.
