

Citizen Park/Concession Stand

930 N 18th St

Citizen Park formerly housed the Manitowoc County fairgrounds and is named after the schooner Citizen, which was built in Manitowoc in 1847 and was believed to be one of the first clipper ships produced on the Great Lakes.



Park Shelter Information:

- **Rental rates per day (9 AM—11 PM) with tax included:**
 - **Open air shelter fee (9'x31' porch only):** Weekdays: \$50.40, Weekends: \$55.65
 - **Concession stand fee (porch & indoors):** Weekdays: \$71.40, Weekends: \$77.70
 - **Non-resident surcharge:** \$12.60
- **Security deposit:** \$150 for indoor portion
- **Grills:** 1 in area
- **Picnic tables:** 1 but located near a separate Open Air Shelter which has more tables
- **Group size:** Perfect for your outdoor party
- **Outlets & water:** Available inside the concession stand
- **Public restrooms:** Access from outside of building
- **Amenities:** picnic tables, ball diamonds, off-street parking, near Aquatic Center
