

City of Manitowoc Parks and Recreation Dept. has approximately 2.5 miles of marked and groomed fat tire bike trails located at Silver Creek Park. The trailhead is located near the Silver Creek Fieldhouse and restrooms south of the parking lot next to the storage shed. Grooming equipment and grooming of the trail is being provided by a local volunteer group, the "Heavy Pedal Velo" bike club. The trail is only open when ground is frozen and snow conditions allow. This trail is not a designated bike trail outside of the winter fat bike season. See city bike trail map for other bike options in spring, summer, fall seasons. Currently the use of groomed trails does not require a trail pass or user fee. Please follow the guidelines below:

Please...

- Ride at your own risk.
- Ride only when trails are posted "OPEN".
- Follow trail signs and closures.
- Obey safe biking guidelines including wearing your helmet.
- Stay on marked trails.
- Yield right-of-way to all other park users (including disc golfers).
- Report trail hazards, violations and incidents to City Park Staff (920.323.4194).
- DO NOT BIKE IF YOU ARE RUTTING SNOW OR DIRT!
